2	A disc on the path or right of the string line is O.B.	Not Played on Sunday
3	A disc on the path or left of the string line is O.B. Normal pin location	A disc on the path or left of the string line is O.B. Pin in long position
4	Mandatory flight path to the right of the marked pole. A missed mando must be played from the drop zone at the bottom of the hill. Normal Tee	Creek is O.B. Tee is under the overpass.
5	The creek and left of the string line is O.B. Normal Pin location	The creek and left of the string line is O.B. Pin is in long (Hole 2) location.
6	The path and north (right) of the path is O.B. Drop zone mandatory for O.B. throw from tee.	No Change
7	Mandatory flight path to the left of the marked pole. A missed mando must be played from the drop zone near the pole.	Same mandatory rules. Pin is located in alternate location.
8	The parking lot is O.B.	The parking lot is O.B.. Tee is in long position.
9	Mandatory flight path to the left of the marked pole. A missed mando must be played from the drop zone near the pole.	No Change
9B	The creek is O.B. The drop zone is optional.	No Change
10	This is a large island hole. The path and everything beyond the path is O.B.	Not Played on Sunday
10A	Not Played on Saturday	This is a large island hole. The path and everything beyond the path is O.B. Tee is long, pin is short.
10B	Not Played on Saturday	The path and south of the path is O.B. Tee is on bath near creek. Pin is normal 10.
11	The path is O.B. Pin is in short/normal location	The path is O.B. Pin is in long location (normal/long location for hole 1)
12	All pavement, the curb, and right of the string line is O.B. Penalty shot must be played from drop zone. Pin is on island.	Parking lot is O.B. A disc to the right of the string line is O.B. Pin in normal location
